The Philippines

It's an Asian country located in the tropics. The Spanish name "Filipinas" was given by the Spanish explorer Villalobos in 1543 to honor the Prince of Asturias, who later became the King Phillip II of Spain. However, the name is no longer used. The official name now, it is, Republic of the Philippines. The country is made up of 7,100 islands, but only eleven of them are major islands. Only 1000 islands are populated, which means most of them are inhabited. An old legend says that the Philippines were formed when a giant threw a huge mass of rock into the sea. The truth is, the islands were created by volcanoes. Two large islands, Luzon and Mindanao and the group of small islands between them are represented by the three stars on the Philippine flag. Most of its people live near the water, for instance, the large rivers that are on the main islands. For that reason, when natural disasters hit the territory, people usually get hurt. Floods often damage roads and bridges and windstorms cause property damage and loss of life.
